There is no charge for these concerts but there will be a retiring collection in aid of our Church Funds (6th August in aid of Chernobyl victims).



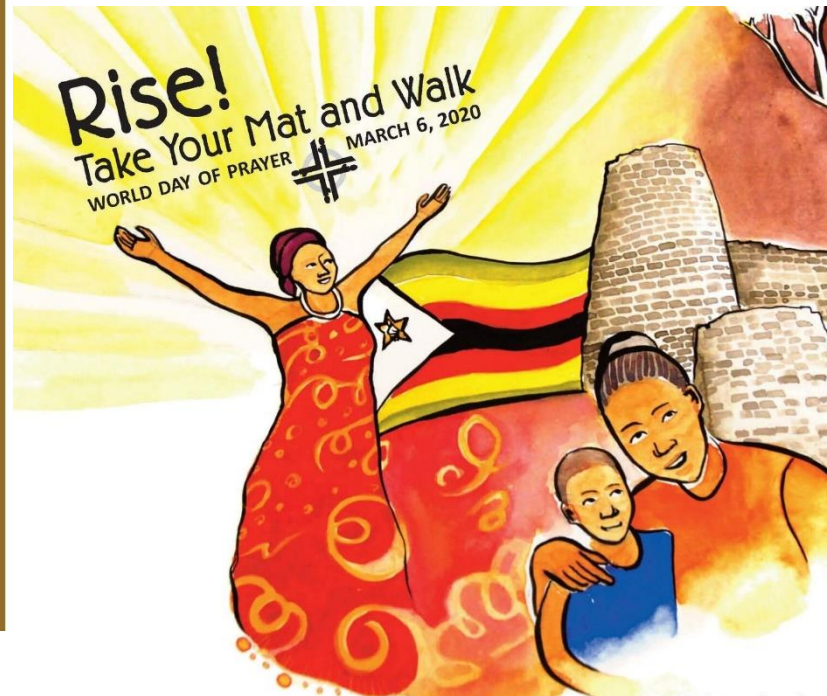
